Continents	A continent is one of Earth's seven
	main divisions of land.
Location	Where a certain place is.
Hemisphere	Half of a sphere. The Earth is
	divided into two hemispheres.
Equator	An imaginary line around the Earth
	that goes exactly midway between
	the North Pole and the South Pole.
Environment	The environment is a place or area
	where a person, plant or animal
	live.
Weather	Weather is the way the air and the
	atmosphere feels. It includes the
	outside temperature, strength of
	the wind, and whether it is raining,
	sunny, hailing, snowing, sleeting,
	foggy, or cloudy.
Compass	A tool for finding a direction on
	the Earth's surface that points
	towards north.

- The Earth is divided into the Northern hemisphere and the Southern hemisphere.
